Hiatus is the Brussels-based contemporary dance company of choreographer and dancer Daniel Linehan. Linehan's choreographic work is intent on softly obscuring the line that separates dance from everything else. He approaches performance-making from the point of view of a curious amateur, testing various interactions between dance and non-dance forms, searching for unlikely conjunctions, juxtapositions, and parallels between texts, movements, images, songs, videos, and rhythms.

Hiatus creates new openings for meaningful engagement, to share more often and more deeply with the public, creating space for our values to resonate with the public, as we care for ourselves and our greater community. Each project of Hiatus aims to create an opening that fosters human-human connections in the here and now: bringing attention to our physical surroundings and our social environment, whether it is in a theater or in a studio or outdoors or any place we go. Hiatus is active: actively questioning, actively listening and responding, emphasizing the value of creative processes and public experiences. Hiatus collaborates and shares in ways that cultivate the values we wish to see in the world: care, meaningful engagement, community, open communication, and creating time and space to be inspired together and learn from each other.

You realize the production from A to Z within the boundaries of the artistic direction and in respect of the predetermined timings and budget. You can find the right balance between the creative, technical and financial aspects of production.

You organize from A to Z national & international touring of Hiatus' creations and you accompany the team on tour.

You are available to travel in the frame of the tours of the company.

You organize and coordinate the creation process of the new creation Listen Here.

You find your way in the administration of a company/an association: making contract, understanding budget, managing author rights questions, etc.

Together with the company manager you keep an eye on the communication and social media.

You work continuously in close consultation with the company manager.

You are a team player. You have the ability to listen towards everyone's needs and you demonstrate a great responsiveness and adaptability.
